

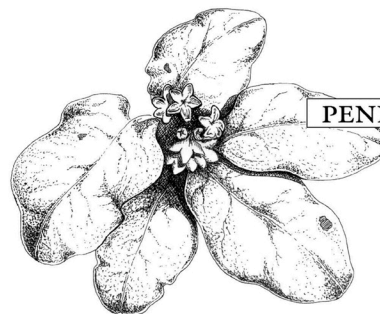


Pennsylvania Native Plant Society Demonstration Garden
